The Parkes Aero Spectacular April 14, 2018

Airborne arrival notes

Refer NOTAM and ERSA for current details.

Special NOTAM conditions will be in place on the day of the event.

Inbound aircraft must be on the ground by 10am (local time) and departures may commence after 15:30hrs (local time).

Plan to avoid R525 approx 10NM north of YPKS as it will be active from surface to 5000' AMSL.

VHF frequencies: CTAF: 126.7MHz

FIA Melb centre: 135.25MHz AWIS: 128.55MHz (ph:8302-7544)

Arrival:

Due to expected traffic volume, straight in approaches are not recommended.

Please make a 10 mile inbound broadcast and listen for circuit traffic to establish the active runway. If the active runway is undetermined please plan to overfly to observe the wind direction and let down on the dead side of the chosen circuit. Please be aware that YPKS is an RPT airport, and as such the **over-fly height is not below 2000' AGL**.

All runways employ left-hand circuits.

A parking area for visiting aircraft will be set aside on the grassed area to the north of the tar apron, (to the east of Taxi-way C) BYO tie-down kit including ground anchors.

Landing runway	Taxi procedure to Parking Area
04	Enter and backtrack RWY29, then taxiway D
22	Taxiway C or taxiway B
11	Taxiway D <i>or</i> backtrack RWY04 then taxiway C
29	Backtrack RWY29, then backtrack RWY04, then taxiway C <i>or</i>
	Taxiway A then enter and cross RWY04 then taxiway B

Please follow instruction from ground-based personnel and you will be led to your parking space.

Tanker and bowser fuelling options available, refer ERSA for details.

YPKS is a security controlled airport (the usual restrictions apply). After arrival people arriving by private aircraft must remain on the "public" side of the event barriers.

There will be no "under-wing" camping on Air-side. Space for fly-in tenters will be made available adjacent to the event car-parking area. These will be unprepared and un-powered site so you'll be camping at your own risk. Please also note that Parkes is home to numerous fine caravan parks and camping grounds.
